If you do not turn in your form, you will not get service work performed at rally. Parts can not be guaranteed after the April 24th service form deadline.

Factory Tours –Did you know we offer factory tours during rally week for attendees? Tour times and the sign-up link will be available towards the end of April. You will be responsible for traveling to our campus in Elkhart from the fairgrounds for your tour. Tours will be located at 301 Benchmark Dr., Elkhart, which is about 25 minutes from the fairgrounds. Display Units –Interested in seeing the latest and greatest within the Alliance RV product lines? There will be display units available at rally for attendees to walk through. The floorplans that will be available will not be decided until the week before rally since it will be based on what is coming off the production line at that time.

Friday Night Wrap-Up Social –We have decided to do dinners a little differently this year, and we will be eliminating potluck night. Instead, we will be having a BBQ meal, an Italian meal, and a Rally Wrap-Up Social! Menus are below for dietary restriction planning purposes.

Dinner Options include—Chipotle burrito (chicken, steak, or veggie); Ben’s Pretzel Calzone (pizza, ham & cheese, chicken-bacon-ranch, or Hawaiian) and pretzel bites; Chick-fil-A original chicken sandwich with chips, Chick-fil-A 8-count nuggets with chips, or Chick-fil-A Cobb salad with grilled chicken

Tank Cleaning –Fellow Allies, Mark and Christy Olson from Tank Rangers of Northern Alabama RV Tank Service will be on-site at the Fairgrounds from May 25–30 offering professional black and gray tank cleaning, water heater flushes, and emergency services using cutting-edge, eco-friendly equipment. Rally Special Pricing is \$299, or \$275 with Early Bird booking by May 24. For guests in water & electric-only sites, don’t worry—they’ve got you covered. Tank Rangers is bringing in a dedicated mobile pump-out system specifically for this event, allowing full service at non-sewer sites; due to this added capability, there is an additional \$25 fee, which includes a complete pump-out during your cleaning—so as a bonus, you’re essentially getting a pump-out service for \$25 versus the \$65 honey wagon rate, all while having your tanks professionally cleaned. When you factor in the \$15/night savings on your water/electric campsite compared to a full hookup site, this fee is more than offset—making it a strong overall value. Rig Washing Service –AALL Brite & Unusual Detailing will be the exclusive RV Wash vendors for the rally. You are permitted to wash your own RV - but please don't contract with another firm to come into the Fairgrounds. Rig Weighing Service –The RV industry funded RVSEF will be offering Rig Weighing services on arrival days May 24-26 and departure day May 30. You can have your rig weighed and receive a report with wheel-by-wheel weights. There is a fee for this service. This will be charged by and paid to the RVSEF prior to receiving your report from them. Advance registration is requested. They will do their best to get the parts and have them in the service building for you to pick up at rally. All parts needed for your approved minor service work will be taken care of by our service team. You do NOT need to order parts associated with your three minor service requests.

Cancellations –We understand that things come up, which is why we offer a very flexible cancellation policy found [here](#). Please understand that the closer we are to the start of rally, the harder it will be to fill your spot due to people making other travel plans and service work no longer being offered due to parts shipping limitations. If you need to cancel, we ask that you let us know [as soon as possible](#). We continue to have a waitlist of people eager to be a part of this year's rally and we'd hate to have sites go empty due to last minute cancellations. Thank you for your help in ensuring all sites are filled.
